QDPortal6 Program (Version 1 for DOCLINE 6.1)

Introduction

In March 2019, the U.S. National Library of Medicine updated their website DOCLINE to version 6.1. For QuickDoc to continue working with DOCLINE6.1 and later versions a new QDPortal (called QDPortal6) is required. No updates to QuickDoc are required. Remember that QDPortal saves data from DOCLINE and QuickDoc is used to manage that data, they are separate all separate but interwoven entities.

The U.S. National Library of Medicine (N.L.M) has left some Inter Library Loan actions on their old website <u>https://docline.gov/docline/</u> and moved other actions over to their new website <u>https://newdocline.docline.gov/docline/</u> because of the gradual phasing of functionality from the old website to the new one, QDPortal will need to be updated with each new version of DOCLINE. The QDPortal you have been using will work with the old website (<u>https://docline.gov/docline/</u>) and the new QDPortal6 will work for the new website (<u>https://newdocline.gov/docline/</u>). As of March 4, 2019 to decide which website and application to use for a given action please adhere the chart (p. 2) provided by N.I.H.



- 3. Open the QDPortal6 application and click the "Setup" button



Instructions Usage

- 1. Use the new DOCLINE website as instructed by N.L.M. it works in similar fashion to their old website most changes are purely visual
- 2. To import Borrows, Lends, and Lend Updates from a given day choose the date the borrow or lend receipt of issued by DOCLINE then click either the Import Borrow Receipts or Import Lend Receipts Button depending on which you want to import. Because Lend Receipts and Borrow Receipts can be update latest actions by DOCLINE days after they were issued (e.g. a lend being filled) It is recommended that you import Borrows and Lends at the end of every day. If you happen to miss a day fear not, for you can select days in the past and retrieve the data so long as it is available on the DOCLINE website.
